**The 7 tenets of the Huntington Jewish Center's
Student/Parent *Kavod** Covenant**

Our signatures below indicate that we have read the school's policies and understand our responsibility to the Huntington Jewish Center community by sticking to them. Respectful, *kavod* behavior, includes:

1. Speaking with *kavod* - not interrupting fellow students or educators, sharing challenging thoughts or disagreeing without belittling the subject or the speaker.
2. Dressing with *kavod* - especially considering how I prepare myself to enter a ritual or spiritual service, dressing with *kavod* also includes wearing a head covering during school.
3. Eating on the premises with *kavod* – being sensitive to the HJC kosher guidelines, fellow student's allergies, as well as traditional or non-traditional blessings before and after eating.
4. General *kavod* for people - never physically engaging with fellow students or teachers in an unkind manner, listening and responding to the people when they speak to me.
- 5 General *kavod* for the premises - not touching bulletin boards or writing on them inappropriately and cleaning up after snack.
6. *Kavod* for learning - attend a minimum of 75% of class time and contacting the classroom teacher whenever an absence takes place. In the event that illness or circumstances causes more than 25% absence, make-up work will be completed before the end of the semester and ongoing communications (via phone or email) will take place between my family and the classroom teacher. Bringing required books, homework and supplies, as well as aiming to come on time as best as possible, conducting myself with maximum efforts while in classes or programs is also integral to showing *kavod* for my learning..
7. *Kavod* for community prayer - attend and participate (with my voice, thoughts and movement) in at least a minimum of 10 Shabbat services for grades 3 – 7. And 8 Shabbat services for grades K – 2.?
